

**ITT Corporation/IPFW Scholarships
With Possible Internships
Application Form and Criteria for Continuing Students**

Criteria for Scholarship with Possible Internship:

1. Must be a full-time student committed to completing a baccalaureate degree on a full-time basis (enrolled in at least 12 credit hours) each Fall and Spring semester during the academic year.
2. Must have an overall GPA of 3.0 or greater in one of the following majors and remain in one of these majors:
 - computer engineering
 - mechanical engineering
 - computer science
 - equivalent engineering technology disciplines
 - electrical engineering
3. Must demonstrate academic ability to succeed at IPFW and agree to an academic progress review each semester.
4. Must provide a recommendation letter from an IPFW faculty member.
5. Must submit an essay (1-2 paragraphs) detailing career goals in their major and why they would like to be considered for the scholarship with a possible company internship.
6. Must provide a resume.
7. Must complete the scholarship application by **February 1, 2009** (on back).
8. Must provide an unofficial copy of your latest transcript.
9. Student award winner may renew annually by reapplying. In order to be eligible, the student must meet the above criteria and be willing and eligible to accept an internship if offered by ITT.
10. This scholarship award is restricted to tuition and administrative fees at IPFW.
