Criteria for Incoming Freshmen

Criteria for Scholarship with Possible Internship:

1. Must be a full-time student committed to completing a baccalaureate degree on a full-time basis (enrolled in at least 12 credit hours) each Fall and Spring semester during the academic year.
2. Must be admitted to one of the following majors and remain in one of these majors:
 - computer engineering
 - computer science
 - electrical engineering
 - mathematics
 - physics
3. Must demonstrate academic ability to succeed at IPFW and agree to an academic progress review each semester. An overall GPA of 3.0 or greater must be maintained while enrolled in one of the majors listed in Item 2.
4. Must provide a recommendation letter from a high school guidance counselor or teacher.
5. Must submit an essay (1-2 paragraphs) detailing career goals in their major and why they would like to be considered for the scholarship with a possible company internship.
6. Must provide a resume.
7. Must complete the scholarship application by **March 1, 2009** (attached).
8. Must provide an official copy of your latest transcript.
9. Student award winner may renew annually by reapplying. In order to be eligible, the student must meet the above criteria and be willing and eligible to accept an internship if offered by a company.
10. This scholarship award is restricted to tuition and administrative fees at IPFW.
