ELECTRICAL AND COMPUTER ENGINEERING TECHNOLOGY

Here is a listing of available scholarships. **Please complete a separate application for each scholarship for which you are applying.** Applications are **due by March 1, 2008**. Scholarships vary in amount and availability each year and most are awarded in April. For more information, contact Karen at 260 (481-6338). Additional scholarships may be available through Financial Aid (481-6820).

Engineering, Technology, and Computer Science Scholarships for Excellence (*All majors*)

Criteria: Student can be full-time or part-time. Full-time students will be committed to completing either the associate or baccalaureate degree on a full-time basis and have taken at least 12 credit hours in the Fall 2007 semester and also in the Spring 2008 semester. MUST plan to take at least 12 credit hours for the Fall semester 2008. Part-time students will be committed to completing either the associate or baccalaureate degree on a part-time basis and have taken at least 3 credit hours in the Fall 2007 semester and also in the Spring 2008 semester. MUST plan to take at least 6 credit hours for the Fall semester 2008. Student must have a GPA of 3.0 and not be involved with a company tuition refund program. Scholarship is also available to incoming freshmen.

American Electric Power (AEP) Scholarship Program (*CS, ECET, ENGR*)

Criteria: Student can be full-time or a part-time continuing student or an incoming new student. Student must have a financial need and preference will be given to a minority student.

Armed Forces Communication and Electronics Association (AFCEA), Indiana Chapter Scholarship (*CS, CmpE, EE, ECET*)

Criteria: Student must be a U.S. citizen and be majoring in electrical engineering, electrical & computer engineering technology or computer science. Student must be full-time and have a superior academic record.

IPFW Ronald C. Emery Memorial Scholarship (*ECET*) Criteria: Student must a full-time, degree-seeking student majoring in the Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering Technology. Preference will be given to a financial aid student with a cumulative GPA of 3.0.

Fred R. Gideon (*ECET*) Criteria: Student should be full-time, but will consider part-time, majoring in ECET. Preference will be given to a financial aid student with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.

Dr. Maurice S. M. Lam Memorial Scholarship (*ECET, EE*) Criteria: Student must be a degree-seeking student majoring in electrical engineering or electrical and computer engineering technology. Student will be selected on the basis of merit, with financial need a secondary consideration. This award alternates between ECET and EE. This year's recipient will be **ECET**.

Leadership Scholarship (*ECET*) Criteria: Student must be a degree-seeking student majoring in the Department of Electrical and computer Engineering Technology. Must be either a sophomore or junior (>30 credit hours & <90 credit hours) with a cumulative GPA of greater than 2.5. The student must have exhibited leadership and initiative in class, lab, and other IPFW activities. Leadership in community organizations is also highly desirable.

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A SPECIAL APPLICATION IS NEEDED FOR THIS SCHOLARSHIP.

Northeast Indiana Engineers Society (*ECET, ENGR, MCET*)

Criteria: Student should be a sophomore or junior and in a curriculum leading to a B.S. in engineering or engineering technology. <p>ETCS SCHOLARSHIPS FOR EXCELLENCE PROGRAM FOR OUTSTANDING COMMITTED CONTINUING STUDENTS</p>

PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY:

Awards will be made by each of the four departments of the College based on the following criteria:

1. **Full-time students** will be committed to completing either the associate or baccalaureate degree on a full-time basis and have taken at least 12 credit hours in the Fall 2007 semester and also in the Spring 2008 semester. **MUST plan to take at least 12 credit hours for the Fall semester 2008.**

Part-time students will be committed to completing either the associate or baccalaureate degree on a part-time basis and have taken at least 3 credit hours in the Fall 2007 semester and also in the Spring 2008 semester. **MUST plan to take at least 6 credit hours for the Fall semester 2008.**

2. Must have a GPA of 3.0 (B average) or greater in the major.
3. May not be involved with a company tuition refund program, but must be paying for the education from their own resources. However, may be receiving other financial aid including other scholarships.

AWARD BASIS:

Each department and the dean's office will select the students based primarily on scholarship, and secondarily on need.

ENTRY DEADLINE:

The application must be submitted no later than **March 1, 2008.**
