

Update #3 Dec. 15, 2009

Hello Future City participating schools and Pilot Schools:

We are soon approaching 2 Indiana Future City deadlines this Friday, Dec. 18. See below information on:

- 1) Team Registration
- 2) SimCity 4 Deluxe city map submission.

1) TEAM REGISTRATION: Due to technical difficulties with this link, the team registration is not "live" yet. As soon as we have this corrected, it will be activated on the Indiana website. We hope to have it up tomorrow afternoon.

The TEAM REGISTRATION IS NOT THE SAME AS THE SCHOOL REGISTRATION. You registered your school to participate in Future City in the fall either as a fully participating school or as a pilot school. All schools did the same process.

If you plan to attend with a team or teams (up to 3) for the regional event on January 16, 2010, you must complete the Team Registration. This is required for participation. We need to know:

- 1) How many teams from your school will attend the event (3 maximum per school)
- 2) The names of your team/city (or cities)

IMPORTANT: ONCE YOU HAVE NAMED A CITY AND SUBMITTED YOUR TEAM REGISTRATION, THE NAME CANNOT BE CHANGED.

THE NAME ON YOUR SIM CITY MAP, TEAM REGISTRATION, ESSAY, CITY NARRATIVE, AND MODEL ALL MUST BE THE SAME.

3) In the registration, you will be asked to provide the names of the designated 3 student members for each team, their sizes for their free t-shirts, and the names of the teacher(s) and the engineer-mentor(s) associated with each team. One teacher or engineer may work with multiple teams.

While any number of students can attend as observers (and we encourage this if they worked on the project and the students doing the presentation are "representatives" of a class or club), you can still only register 3 official team members. If something happens where you need to change the students prior to the event, we do allow changes up until the week of the event. Please do not change students after the Monday of the event week except under extenuating circumstances. The new substituted person's name will not appear in the program as they go to print on the Monday before the Indiana Regional Competition and all event materials like badges and certificates are printed by Wednesday of the event week.

There is no cost for team registration.

If you are planning on registering a team and then they don't complete the essay and city narrative, they can still come to the competition with their model, present and compete however, they would not be eligible to advance to the finals because of those missing elements. They would be able to participate in the model displays and eligible for some of the Special Awards.

Even if you do not complete your model but have submitted the other items, your team may attend the event to see the displays and watch the finals in the afternoon.

The official 3 members of each team, the teacher, the engineer-mentor receive free t-shirts. Engineers and teachers with multiple teams will receive only one t-shirt. Other t-shirts may be requested at your cost. The orders for any extra t-shirts must be sent to me by email with all quantities and sizes before this Friday at noon.

The teacher, engineer, and team names can be added or changed until the week of the event. Once you have attended the Regional as the official teacher, mentor, or team member, no other person can be substituted to attend Nationals if your team wins.

2. Submit your SimCity map design in 2 ways:

Submit your city map by copying your city to a DVD or CD (ALWAYS KEEP A COPY YOURSELF) and then put the name of your city on the CD/DVD and mail it with the *COMPLETED* form on page 51 called:

SIMCITY MAP SUBMISSION ON THE INDIANA WEBSITE: [www.etc.ipfw.edu/fcc](http://www.etc.ipfw.edu/fcc)

On the home page, click on the link to open the submit page. Write the correct city name in the box. Browse your files (you must have the city on your hard drive) and highlight the city file making sure that you have the correct name on the city file and then click on the "send SimCity Disk" to submit.

PENALTIES: There is a 5 point penalty for each submitted item that is late.
