Best Verbal Presentation	Future City Committee	The highest presentation score in the preliminary round of competition.
Best City Abstract	Future City Committee	The highest scoring abstract.
Best SIMCITY Design	Future City Committee	The highest scoring SIMCITY disk design.
Best City Name	Future City Committee	The most unique, memorable name for a city voted on by the committee members.
Best City Wide Transportation	Citilink	The city with the most economical, pollution free, innovative transportation design.
Best City for Public Health & Safety	Future City Committee	The city that best exemplifies a plan and the facilities for keeping its citizens safe and healthy.
Best Essay		The highest scoring essay.
Best City Model		The team that receives the highest score for their model design.
People's Choice Award		The award voted on by all teams and observers as the favorite city of the competition.
Best Use of Recycled Content	Allen County Solid Waste Management District	The city that makes the best use of recycled materials in their model. Included in this is the amount of recycled materials used, creativity in the transformation of recycled materials, and the ability to take recycled materials and make them resemble elements of city architecture.
Best Asphalt Pavement Design	Brooks Construction & Asphalt Pavement Association of IND., Inc.	The city with the most creative design of asphalt pavement in their city model and the team that can best explain the reasons for the superior use of asphalt materials for paving roadways, walkways, etc.
Best Layout of a Manufacturing Area	Society of Manufacturing Engineers Chapter 56	The city showing that their manufacturing area has been well planned so that it is visually appealing, easily accessible and is not a source of pollution.
Most Innovative Use of Engineering	Northeast Indiana Engineers Week Committee	The city that displays and can explain creative and innovative engineering of any type within their city.
Best Emergency Response Plan	American Red Cross	The city with a response plan that is appropriate for a natural disaster (hurricane, tornado, flood, weapons of mass destruction) that includes protocol for what would happen immediately following the disaster to aid citizens and how the community would prepare in advance for this plan.
Best Illustration of Land Surveying	NE Chapter Indiana Society of Professional Land Surveyors	The model that displays the initiative and ingenuity of the design team. Geometric, block, street, and intersection design principles in addition to the placement of structures shall be part of the judging criteria.
